It doesn't really matter? It's all the same now because somehow CSTs, Server Admins, Networking and RF are the same thing?

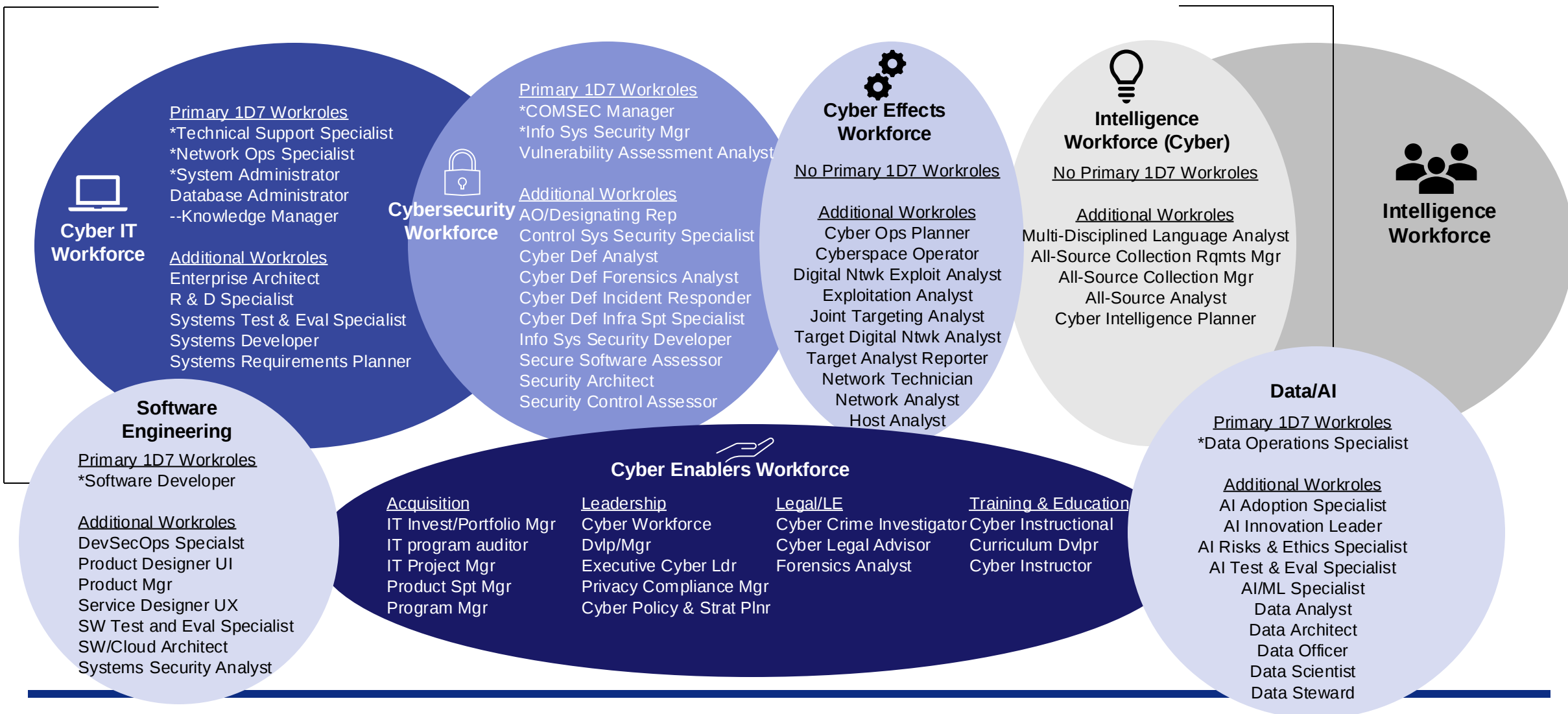

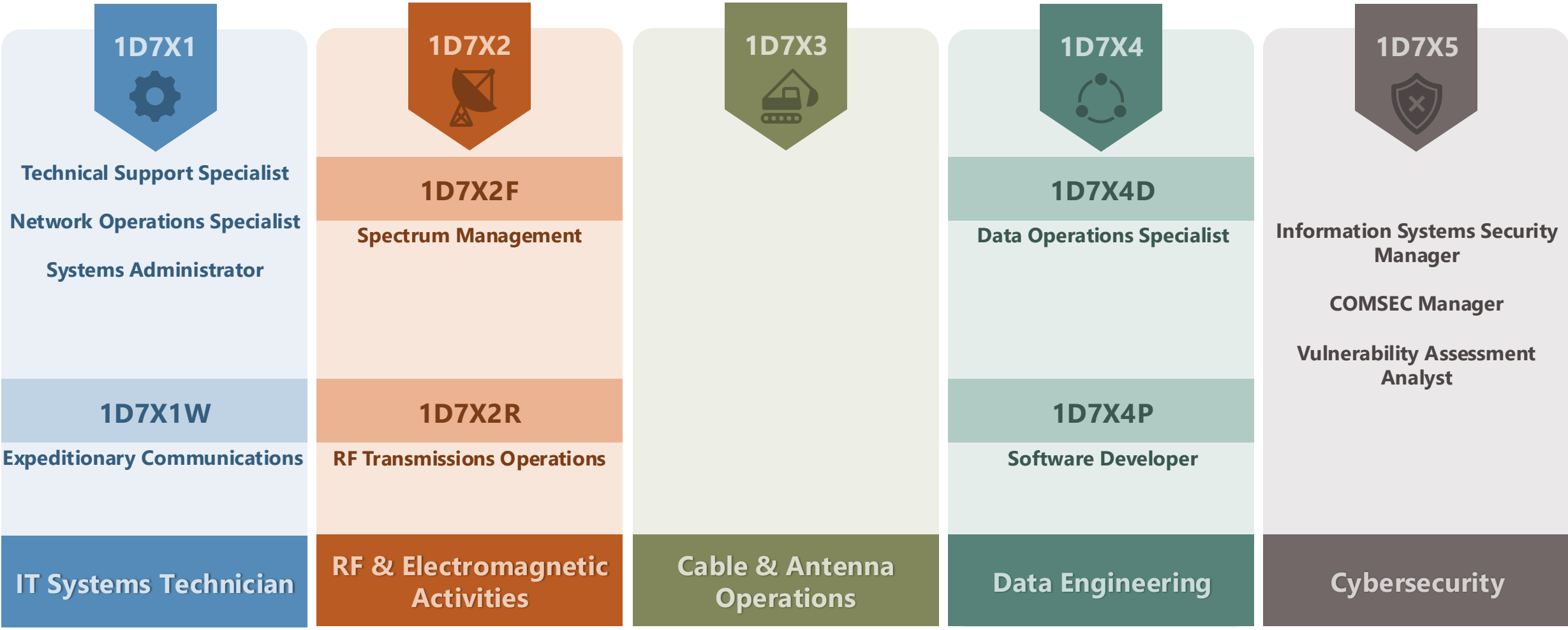
DCWF Elements and Work roles
