MCCC's are there to help. Don't wait until imminent CCRI to ask!

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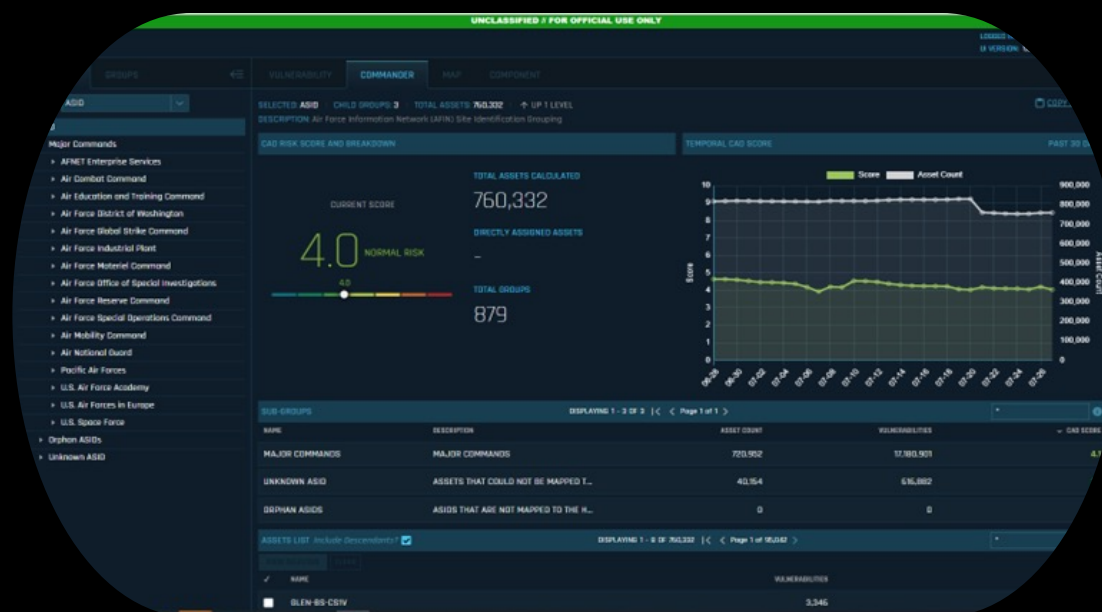
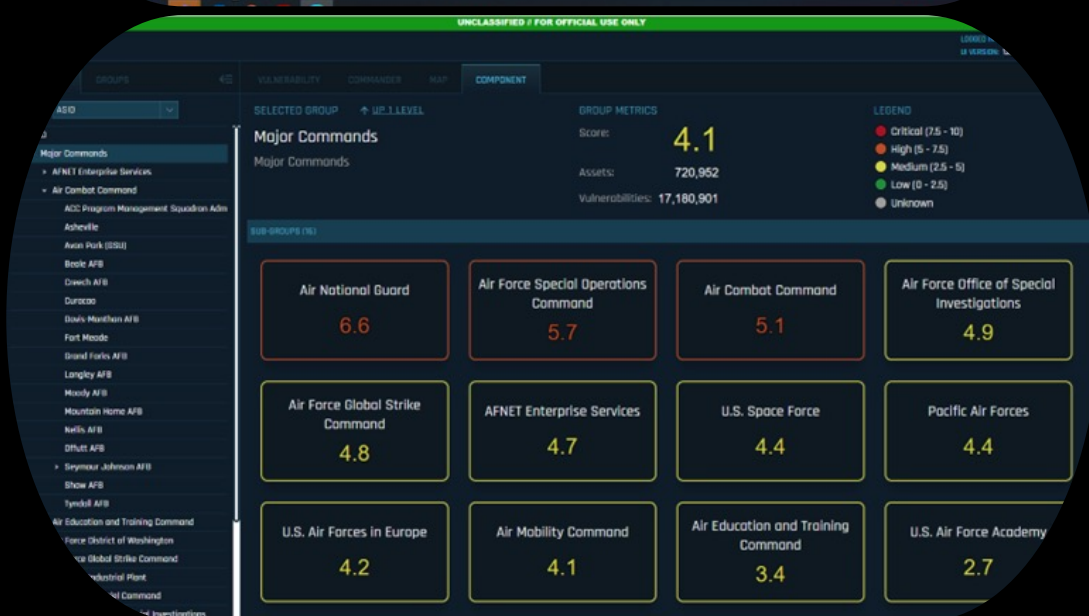
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Cyber Awareness Dashboard

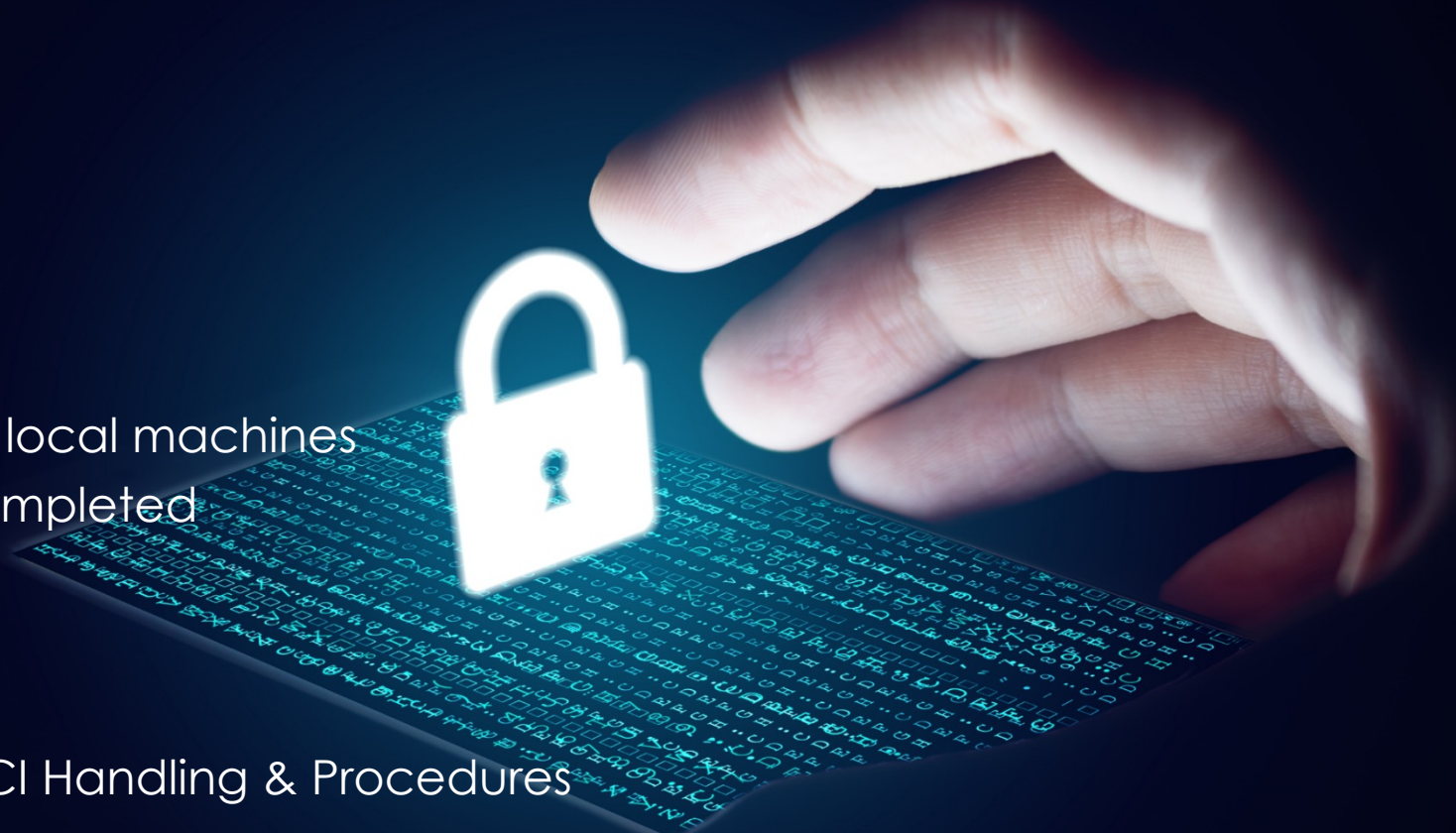
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Negligent Discharge of Classified Information

- Why Safeguard Information?
- NDCI Occurs, Wing Reports, and CFP Contains and Sanitizes
 - Declare within 5 days
 - Enterprise Sanitization
 - Base CFP contains and sanitizes local machines
 - Local sanitization is last to be completed
 - Accounts will be unlocked
- IAW AFCYBER TASKORD 22-2022 NDCI Handling & Procedures





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16 AF/AFCYBER CSSP

All DoD Components must have a Cyber Security Service Provider (CSSP) (DoDI 8530.0)

- 16 AF is AFIN CSSP (DAF CIO memo, 1 May 2019)
- Info system owners must align to 16 AF CSSP (AFI 17-130)

What does CSSP alignment do for you?

- Required for ATOs and CCRIs
- Connects system owners to cybersecurity resources
- Streamlines notification of external threats

- NC3 and SAP onboarding
- USCYBERCOM COF Group 3 operationalization
