# What is SBEAS?



## What is SBEAS?

➤ The replacement multiple award ID/IQ contract for NC2 ASSB. The purpose of this ID/IQ contract is to provide access to a wide range of IT services and solutions that support the IT lifecycle. It is available for use by Business Systems Enterprise (BES), AF MAJCOMs and other agencies that support an Air Force requirement.

## Scope

- The comprehensive suite of IT services and IT solutions to support IT systems and software development in a variety of environments and infrastructures.
- Additional IT services include, but are not limited to documentation, operations, deployment, cybersecurity, configuration management, training, commercial off-the-shelf (COTS) product management and utilization, technology refresh, data and information services, information display services and business analysis for IT programs.

# Program Office Responsibilities



- **Advise customers and contractors on proper use of IDIQs**

SUBJECT: Small Business Enterprise Application Solutions (SBEAS): FA8771-17-R-1000 Delegation of Procurement Authority (DPA) for Ordering Contracting Officer (OCO) to Compete, Award, and Administer Task Orders

1. The purpose of this DPA is to ensure that the roles and responsibilities between the IDIQ CO and the OCO are clearly established, and to authorize the OCO to compete requirements, award task orders, and administer task orders.
2. The authority granted to you under this DPA is limited to the named IDIQ and those Task Orders awarded by you or another OCO possessing a valid DPA in your current warranting organization. The DPA authority does not extend to the IDIQ Basic Contract or Task Orders awarded by other OCOs outside your current warranting organization. You will act as the central point of contact under each Task Order and are responsible for coordinating with the awarded Contractor, the Customers (the funding organization/receiver of goods or services) and The United States Air Force. This applies regardless of whether your contracting organization is acting as the Servicing Agency on behalf of a customer outside your agency or if you are the Requesting Agency for your own organization's requirement. You will perform all required pre and post award functions associated with the task order subject to the following terms and conditions of this DPA:
  - a. **Compliance** – You are expected to comply with the IDIQ's terms and conditions, the IDIQ's ordering/user's guide, the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) or authorized agency supplement or exception thereto, applicable agency-specific statutes and policies, and the additional responsibilities defined in this DPA.
  - b. **Duration** – This DPA is effective until the expiration of the respective IDIQ contract or completion and closeout of the resultant Task Orders, whichever is later. You are also required to maintain a valid warrant authority. Notwithstanding the preceding, this DPA is as portable as your warrant. That is, if you change organizations and your warrant is still valid, the DPA is portable; you still maintain your DPA. However, if you change organizations and your warrant is no longer valid, this DPA is automatically revoked. In the event that you are re-warranted in a new federal organization (DoD or Civilian), a new DPA request will be expedited. The DPA cannot be redelegated.

# Task Order FOPRs



- **North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) Code**
  - The NAICS code for each task order issued must be 541511, which is the NAICS code assigned to the SBEAS IDIQ.
  - You must use, even if a more specific one may apply for your requirement
- **Requirements Approval Document (RAD)**
  - SBEAS has an approved blanket RAD; Individual RADs may not be required for orders (check for local and MAJCOM policy)
  - The blanket RAD for SBEAS, #20392, is posted on the website (link below)

- **Small Business Coordination Record (DD Form 2579)**

Each task order issued against the SBEAS contract requires an approved DD 2579



# Task Order FOPRs



- **Task Order RFPs must include contract clauses specific to the order, examples include ...**
  - Option Clauses – If options are being utilized, the option clauses **MUST** be cited in the TO RFP and included in the TO
  - Tax Clauses – If OCONUS performance is required, the tax clauses appropriate to the country/region of performance must be cited in the TO RFP and included in the TO
  - Government Property
  - Payment (Wide Area Workflow) Information/Instructions
- **H137 Task Order RFP Procedures**
  - Sets expectations for our vendors
  - Addresses the proposal process (including technical and cost/price)



# Task Order FOPRs



## ■ Cover Letter

Basic RFP/RFQ information – ID #, due date/time, POC info, solicitation provisions, SBEAS control number, etc.

## ■ Instructions to Offerors

- Indicate format, page limits, etc.
- Ask only for things you are evaluating
  - Ensure consistent with evaluation criteria
  - Level of detail required for evaluation

## ■ Evaluation Criteria/Procedures (FAR 16.505 – Ordering)

- Price
- Technical
- Past performance



# Task Order FOPRs



## ■ FOPR Dissemination

- The Government may disseminate Request for Information (RFIs), Request for Proposals (RFPs) and Fair Opportunity Proposal Requests (FOPRs) via e-mail, facsimile, commercial mail carrier or other electronic means as prescribed by the OCO's agency. **Please courtesy copy the SBEAS PMO organizational box ([aflcmc.hic.smallbusiness@us.af.mil](mailto:aflcmc.hic.smallbusiness@us.af.mil)) on all emailed solicitations.**
- Solicitation synopsis in Sam.gov is not required or recommended under indefinite-delivery contracts

## ■ Award of Requirement

- Post Award Notices and debriefing of awardees for orders exceeding \$10 million: The contracting officer shall notify unsuccessful awardees when the total price of a task or delivery order exceeds \$10 Million

# SBEAS FAQs



## Q. WILL THE SBEAS PROGRAM OFFICE PROVIDE A SCOPE DETERMINATION?

A. Scope determinations are the Ordering Contracting Officer's (OCO) responsibility. However, the SBEAS PMO is available to assist with this by providing a "scope analysis" at the request of the OCO that can be used to assist him/her in making their determination.

## Q. WHAT IS THE TASK ORDER PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE?

A. The performance period for each task order shall be cited in each individual order and may extend beyond the expiration date of this ID/IQ contract. The period of performance for any task order shall not extend more than five (5) years beyond the last day of the basic contract ordering period (e.g. a task order issued on the last day of the ordering period of the basic contract could have a one (1) year base period and four (4) one (1) year option periods)



# ***FAQ:CLIN Structure***



- Orders must be issued IAW the awarded IDIQ
- Ordering offices must use the CLIN appropriate to both the contract type and ordering period
- CLINs cannot be used if they have not been awarded in the basic IDIQ; CLINS include/indicate the ordering period
- CLINs are used to track contract ceiling
- CLINs are used to track usage of contract type
- Accuracy of SAM.gov reporting is dependent upon appropriate use of CLIN structure
- More than one CLIN type can be used, if required – FP, CR, LH

**Do NOT deviate from the awarded CLIN structure**

Each number identified in the CLIN represents a specific element of the ID/IQ contract. For example, the base year period CLIN 0010 is broken down into four (4) distinct components:

- The first digit represents which period of the basic contract the order was issued
- The second and fourth positions can be used at OCO's discretion
- The third position indicates which contract type has been selected



# SBEAS MythBusters



- **SBEAS vendors can not do agile - !!!MYTH!!!!**
  - Excerpt from the SBEAS SOO: 3.1.5 Software development using various methodologies to include Agile, Prototype, Dev Ops, Rapid, Dynamic, Lean, or Waterfall. Agile is the preferred methodology
  - SBEAS vendors are capable of Agile
- **SBEAS vendors are not capable of what large businesses can do – !!!MYTH!!!**
  - The SBEAS Mentor/Protégé partnerships indicate the capability for reach-back execution with seasoned, successful large businesses
  - Example – 1CYBERFORCE is an Economically Disadvantaged, Women-Owned Small Business partnered with ECS Federal/Indrasoft. Indrasoft is a highly successful vendor on the NETCENTS 2 ASSB and ASFO IDIQs for DAF, DoD, and other Federal Agencies.
- **A SBEAS control number and signed Delegation of Procurement Authority (DPA) letter is needed for market research and/or Request for Information (RFI) – MYTH!!!**
  - A SBEAS control number and signed DPA are only needed for the official Fair Opportunity Proposal Requests (FOPR) or Request for Quotes (RFQ).

Additional IT services include, but are not limited to documentation operations, deployment, cybersecurity, configuration management, training, commercial off-the-shelf (COTS) product management and utilization, technology refresh, data and information services, information display services and business analysis for IT programs. The SBEAS IDIQ contracts are the mandated source of obtaining IT application services and solutions that are within its scope for the Business and Enterprise Systems (BES) and CO's shall consider the use of the SBEAS IDIQ contract vehicle first when meeting BES IT requirements. This contract vehicle is also available for use by all other Air Force MAJCOMs and other agencies that support an Air Force requirement.

**ANNOUNCEMENT:** The ordering period for the NETCENTS2 ASFAO IDIQ Contract is NOT being extended, which means 30 March 2022 is the last day to place orders under the contract. The number of years for task order performance allowed on orders placed at the end of the ordering period for the Acquisition Services Full and Open (ASFAO) contract has been increased from 3 to 5 years. As a result of this modification, Program/Contracting Offices can plan their acquisition strategies accordingly and award task orders that have a 5 year POP (1 base year and 4 option years). There will be NO contract PoP extensions past the end date of the contract (30 March 2027). Contracting Offices should adjust task order awards to occur on or before 30 March 2022. If moving the effective date prior to that is not possible please consult with Mr. Patrick Kinnerson, NETCENTS-2 Application Services PCO, for further guidance.

**ANNOUNCEMENT:** Effective 1 Feb 2022 SBEAS control numbers will be obtained through SharePoint at <https://usaf.dps.mil/sites/NETCENTS/SBEAS/SitePages/Home.aspx>. Additionally, effective 1 Feb 2022, the AFVIAV SBEAS Portal will not be available for control number requests. Customers must use the SharePoint site for SBEAS control number requests and processing as a valid control number is required to order against the IDIQ.

Ordering Contracting Officers may request SBEAS access through SharePoint, which will be utilized to request a scope analysis review, from the SBEAS PMO. CO's will complete the required SBEAS Control Number Questionnaire, and the completed scope analysis memorandum will be returned to the requester using the official SBEAS Oig Box.
